Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc has for some time envisioned owning a Grocery Store that would offer better access to groceries for members. The development of a Grocery Store on-reserve is a goal within the Comprehensive Community Plan.

Like many other First Nations, TteS is driven to explore sustainable opportunities for employment creation, to facilitate food security, and to maximize the positive effects of local development.

The Grocery Store will be TteS owned with a supply relationship with a major grocery supplier. It will feature full grocery selection; superior fresh departments; in-house butcher, bakery, and deli; online ordering and deliveries; meals ready to eat program; and loyalty program.
